At NWBA Forum in September 2013, we launched our core theme for the following year. Various resources and updates will be produced during that period. This call to worship and shared intercession were prepared for the Forum meetings; if you find them helpful, please feel free to use them. Based on Psalm 89, and resonating the key phrase "Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne", the responsive Psalm might be used at the beginning of a service, creating a connection with the prayers of intercession that might be used later.

## Call to worship

**Leader:** We will sing of the Lord's great love for ever;

Response: Our words will make your faithfulness known through all generations.

Leader: We declare that your love stands firm for ever,

Response: that you have established your faithfulness in heaven itself.

Leader: The heavens praise your wonders, Lord,

Response: Your faithful presence summons us, as we gather in your Name

Leader: Who in the skies above can compare with the Lord?

Response: Who is like the Lord among the heavenly beings?

Leader: In the council of the holy ones God is greatly feared;

Response: he is more awesome than all who surround him.

Leader: Who is like you, Lord God Almighty?

Response: You, Lord, are mighty, and your faithfulness surrounds you.

Leader: The heavens are yours, and yours also the earth;

Response: you founded the world and all that is in it.

Leader: You created the north and the south;

Response: Hermon and Tabor sing for joy at your name.

Leader: Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne;

Response: love and faithfulness go before you.

Leader: Blessed are those who have learned to acclaim you, who walk in the light of your presence, Lord. They rejoice in your name all day long; they celebrate your righteousness. For you are their glory and strength,
